Newbshare This Madeleine Rengle (1918-2007) was a Newbury Medal-winning writer of more than 60 books, including the much-loved wrinkles of time. Born in 1918, L'Engle grew up in New York City, Switzerland, South Carolina and Massachusetts. Her father was a reporter, her mother studied to become a pianist, and their home was always full of musicians and theater people. L'Engle graduated from Smith College before returning to New York to work in theater. While touring in the play, she wrote her first book, Little Rain, published in 1945. She met her future husband Hugh Franklin and they both appeared on Cherry Orchard. When it came to Mrs. Franklin, L'Engle gave up the stage in favor of typewriters. In the year her three children were growing up, she wrote four more novels. Hugh Franklin temporarily retired from theater, and his family moved to western Connecticut, where he ran a general store for 10 years. Meet the Austins, the 1960 American Library Association's featured children's book, was based on this experience. The classic time wrinkle of her science fantasy won the 1963 Newbury Medal. Two companion novels, Wind in the Door and a Planet Leaning Quickly (Newbury Honor book), complete what has become known as time trilogy, a series that continues to grow in popularity with a new generation of readers.
